Because of you, 54 deserving students benefitted from the awards provided and 326 more students received tutoring support. Your gift at work from July 1st, 2023, to June 30th, 2024

Academic Success Centre

- The total amount spent this fiscal year was \$74,808, which was used entirely to pay honoraria for Peer Tutors within the Centre
- In the winter 2024 semester, 128 tutors provided 1, 541 individual tutoring hours to 164 students; additionally, 13 tutors provided 66 hours of group tutoring to 162 students
- The amount spent is above the annual allocation outlined in the gift agreement (of \$55,000), because of the residual funds that were remaining in the account of the previous year's donations
- Since 2022 with greater student demand for the services provided by the Centre, the annual spending amount has been above the \$55,000 annual allocation, and the Centre has been able to draw upon the previously unspent funds to meet student needs; there is currently a remaining balance of \$83,082, which the

1000 Women Rising - Finish Line Fund

- The total amount spent this fiscal year was \$27,778, which was entirely used to distribute 41 student awards
- The amount spent is above the annual allocation outlined in the gift agreement (of \$22,000), because of the residual funds that were remaining in the account from previous year's donations, as well as support received towards this project from other donors
- The remaining balance is \$130,319, and we anticipate being able to expend this, on top of the annual allocation by distributing additional awards, in the coming years

Student Association Award

- The total amount spent this fiscal year was \$16,250, which was entirely used to distribute 13 student awards
- The amount spent is above the annual allocation outlined in the gift agreement (of \$15,000), because of the residual funds that were remaining in the account from previous years donations
- The remaining balance is \$108,495, and we anticipate being able to spend this, on top of the annual allocation by distributing additional awards, in the coming years
