

TOWARDS OUR GROCERY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

We have fed 1147 students through our GAP program, contributing over \$65,000 to combat food insecurity. This marks a 65% increase in applications compared to previous years. Thanks to funding from the government, we were able to approve these additional applications. SABVC is continuing to work on fighting food insecurity.
